RESOLUTION NO. 2021-10-18-A

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE GREATER BAR WATER DISTRICT INCREASING WATER RATES FOR 2022-2024

WHEREAS, the Greater Bar Water District Commissioners have the authority and are empowered to adjust rates for water usage in the District; and,

WHEREAS, it is the Commissioners desire to set rates in an equitable and fair manner for all water customers within the District; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to increase the base rate per for each ERU to keep the Greater Bar Water District in a sound financial position and to meet contractual reserve requirements placed by the DOH and USDA for loans granted; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners desire to increase the base rate annually per month for each ERU by \$2.00 in 2022, and \$1.00 per ERU in 2023 and 2024.

WHEREAS, the Commissioners desire to increase the seasonal rate per account to \$34.43 rounded down to \$34.00 per month to reflect the current debt service payments.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE GREATER BAR WATER DISTRICT, DOUGLAS COUNTY, WASHINGTON, AS FOLLOWS:

Effective January 1, 2022, this Resolution amends the current water base rate from \$65.00 per month for each ERU to \$67.00 for the **MOU Rich Acres customers**; on January 1, 2023, rates increase to \$68.00 per ERU in 2023; and on January 1, 2024, rates increase to \$69.00 per ERU for MOU Rich Acres customers.

Effective January 1, 2022, this Resolution amends the current water base rate from \$68.00 per month for each ERU to \$70.00 for the remaining Greater Bar Water District customers; on January 1, 2023, rates increase to \$71.00 per ERU in 2023; and on January 1, 2024, rates increase to \$72.00 per ERU for the remaining GBWD customers.

Effective January 1, 2022, this Resolution amends the seasonal rates to \$34.00 per month per ERU for years 2022, 2023 and 2024.

The vacant rate remains unchanged for these rate adjustment periods.

Water usage allocations remain the same for summer and winter rate periods.
